

4. Object of the Society :

The aim and object of the society shall be according to the memorandum.

5. Membership/Subscription :

Category of Members :-

- A. Ordinary members - Rs 1000/- per annum
- B. Associate members - Rs 2000/- per annum
- C. Corporate members - Rs 10,000/- per annum
- D. Institutional members - Rs 20,000/- per annum.
- E. Service members - (Rs. 2000/- p.a.)
- F. Casual members - Unlimited subscription as per his/her desire/will.
- G. Honorary members - No annual subscription

6. Rules/Duties Of The Journalist Welfare Association

- The name of the institution is The Journalist Welfare Association. The registered office of the Association is Situated at Quarter No. 32 Chak Kabra, ADA Colony, Naini Allahabad 211 008.
- The official year of the Association shall be the financial year, i.e., from 1st April to 31st March.

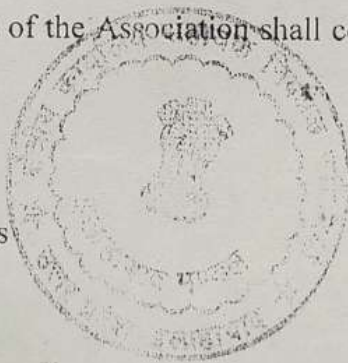
Article 1 :

The Journalist Welfare Association is established for the purpose and object expressed in the Bye-laws under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 and shall be governed by a Managing Committee constituted in accordance with these articles.

Article 2 :

Membership: membership of the Association shall consist of the following categories of persons working for:

- A. Ordinary members
- B. Associate members
- C. Corporate members
- D. Institutional members
- E. Service members
- F. Casual members
- G. Honorary members

Article 3 :

A-Ordinary members —

The following persons are eligible to be considered for admission as ordinary members of the Association:

A working journalist (including persons in positions such as artist, librarian, photographer, calligrapher, index assistants), hereafter referred to as 'journalist', who is employed in a news

agency, registered newspaper or magazine/periodical, house magazines, annuals, directories, casual and festival publications.

OR

A journalist employed by internet news and feature companies or electronic news media, including radio and television channels – including a person in a position such as news TV cameraperson, producer, etc., who is engaged in the collection, analysis and dissemination of news or in the production of news and news-based programmes and current affairs programmes or person involve in media in any type.

B-Associate members-

(i) Associate members – category – I

A person who is working as a public relations manager/officer in a public sector company or in a company listed on any stock exchange in India or registered with a chamber of commerce and industry; or a person working in a nationalized bank or co-operative bank who is associated with the press in the discharge of his/her normal function, will be eligible to be an associate member of the Association provided his/her membership is sponsored and paid for by his/her employer.

(II) Associate members – category – II

Any person working as a communication/public relations manger / representative of a functioning public relations company or recognized advertising agency, manager in the advertising/public relations department of recognized print, internet and electronic media if sponsored by the employer as well as self-employed advertising consultants, is eligible for admission to this category.

C-Corporate members –

This category of non-voting membership will be open to public and private limited companies with a turnover of Rs. 5 lakh and above. The admission fee for corporate members shall be Rs. 10,000 (rupees ten thousand). A corporate member shall be entitled to nominate a maximum of two representatives and will have to pay an annual subscription fee of Rs. 250 for each representative, which will be payable for the full year in which such application is made. Corporate members will have the option of replacing or withdrawing their representatives by intimating the Association in writing. The managing committee may, from time to time, revise the fees in view of the requirements of the Association.

D- Institutional members-

This category of membership will be open to professional institutions and associations of professionals in areas such as information technology, engineering, medicine, architecture and accounting. Each such organization may nominate up to two representatives each. The admission fee shall be Rs. 5,000 (rupees five thousand) and annual membership fee Rs. 500 (rupees five hundred) per representative.

E-service members -

As per the understanding between the journalist welfare Association, and the government of India, one senior official of the Central government's department will be given membership ex officio without any charge. The public relations officers of the central government and of other state governments and local bodies are eligible to become service members. Such members will have to pay an admission fee of Rs. 2,000.00 b and an annual subscription of Rs. 500, payable in advance in April every year, irrespective of

the date of admission. The managing committee may, from time to time, revise the fess in view of the requirements of the Association.

F-Causal members –

Any type of journalist or citizen of India may enroll himself/herself as a casual member of the Association for a period not exceeding one month at any time, after paying subscription. Such member may enjoy the facilities of the Association as a member but shall not entertain guests.

G-Honorary members-

Notwithstanding any other provisions in the rules and regulations of the Association, the membership review Committee shall admit a journalist who has been an ordinary member of the Association for 10 years and who has retired on superannuation, as an honorary member, Such honorary members will have the right to avail themselves of all the facilities of the Association.
